In the Name of God Amen I Samuel Watkins Sen. of Richland District in the State of South Carolina Considering the uncertainty of this Mortal life Being weak in Body But perfect and Sound Mine and Memory Blessed be all Mighty God for the Same Do make and publish this my last will and testament manner and form following that is to Say first I Give and Bequeath unto My Son Samuel one Negro Girl Named Lydia with her Increase from the time She was Delivered to him Next I Give and Bequeath unto My Son Cornelius one Negro Boy Named Elle with my Blacksmith Tools and to My Daughter Milly I give and bequeath one Negro Woman Named Oate and To My Daughter Dorcas I give and Bequeath one Negro Boy Named peter and to my Daughters Mary Patience ~~and Dorcas and Milly~~ I Give and Bequeath all my Stock of all kind with all my house hold and Kitchen Furneture to be Equally Devided among my above Named Daughters and I do hereby appoint my Son Samuel and my Son Cornelius to be my Sole Exetors of this My last will and Testament hereby Revoking alother wills or Deeds heretofore my me Made In witness where off I have here unto Set my hand and Seal this twenty Ninth day of September one thousand Eight hundred and twenty and in the forty Sixth year of the Independence of the united States Signed Seald and declared by the above Named Sam. Watkins Sen. To be his last will and Testament in presents of us who have here unto Subscribed our Names as witnesses in presents of the Testator.
