

In the name of God, Amen - I, Sarah Bougle wife of George Bougle of the Town of Columbia in the District of Richland and State of South Carolina, being feeble of body but of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, in and by virtue of the beneficiary interest which I have in and to certain Real and personal property in the Town of Columbia, separate and apart from and independent of my said Husband, do make and publish this my last will and Testament - that is to say, I hereby give and devise unto John Bryce Esqr., likewise of said Town, all my estate and effects, as well Real or personal, wherever situate and being and of what nature or kind soever (subject to the payment of my just debts, funeral expenses and the charges of proving and executing this my will) in Trust nevertheless for the use, benefit and behoof of my said Husband George Bougle and his heirs or devisees.

And I hereby constitute and appoint the said John Bryce, Trustee and Executor of this my last will and testament, with full power and authority to sell or otherwise dispose of any portion of my estate and effects, whether Real or Personal, at his discretion, for the conversion of the same into any other species of property or investments, for the like benefit of the said George Bougle, his heirs or devisees --
