Mayor John Goodwyn of Richland District deceased, being of
sound mind and disposing memory, but very weak and infirm of
body by reason of Great sickness, do make and declare this to
be my last Will and Testament.- I surrender to the Dust this
body which I received from my creator, and My Soul to him who
gave it giving him Thanks Glory and Praised for all his Mercy
to me, but the more for the Love and Grace and Salvation he
has thro the suffering and Death of our Lord Jesus Christ be-
stowed upon all who sincerely believe and repent. - as for the
worldly good which he in by providence has bestowed It is my
will and desire- that all my Debts and funeral Expences be paid
and I enjoin it specially on my Executors if practicable to pay
the same out of the Share of the Debt due the Estate of Jb. S.
Taylor deceased and out of money owed to me by Jasse M. Howell
Esq. which two several Sums I think will be Sufficient for
that purpose. Item I give and bequeath to my grand Son Charley
Fredrick Goodwyn one negro Girl anne to him and his Heirs Item
I give to my beloved Daughter Adella Frances Goodwyn The Bed-
stead, Bed matrass and all Bed clothes necessary whereon I
usually slept, my chest of Drawers and a set of Bed curtains -
to be purchased for that purpose.- Item I give to my beloved
Son Robt. H. Goodwyn one other Bed stead Bed matrass and bed
clothes necessary.- Item, It is my Will and desired that the
whole of my negro Slaves be by my Executors equally divided
between all my children Viz. Games T Goodwyn Robt. H. Goodwyn
Thos. Jefferson Goodwyn William A. Goodwyn Albert G. Goodwyn
Edward F. Goodwyn Sarah Effs Adams wife of William Adams. Martha
T. Waring wife of Benjn. R. Waring and Adella F/ Goodwyn share
and Share alike to them and the heirs of there Body respecti ely
and it is my request to my Executors that on the delivery of the
said Shares respectively they take from the legatus receipt

specifying the kind of Estate they each of them hold in the said negroes hereby bequeathed to them and that at the proper charge of my Estate they cause the same to be recorded in the proper public office.- all the rest residue and remainder of my Estate both real and personal it is my will and desire, shall be by my Executors sold and the avails there of Equally divided between Each and Every of my Children hereforementioned I appoint my Sons James T. Goodwyn Robt. H. Goodwyn Thos. Goodwyn and my Cousin Benj. F. Taylor to be Executors of this my last Testament and Will and Trustees for the Estate of Such of my Children or may not be of age at my Death until such time or they respectively come of age or be Married hereby revoking all other Wills - dated at Rice Creek this 26th of July 1821.
