THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF JAMES SHIRLING DESEASED.
IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN. I James Shirling being very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given unto God calling unto mind the Mortality of my body & ~~Forasmuch~~ appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will & testament, that is to say, principally & first of all I give and recommend my Soul into the hand of Almighty God that gave it and my body I commend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again, by the mighty power of God. and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me with in this life I give demise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form; First I give and bequeath unto my Brethero Sam John Shirling all my Estate both real and personal forever freely to be Enjoyed by him, and if he should die before he comes to age that the whole of my Estate should fall to my brother John eldest Daughter Beckey freely to be Enjoyed by her----- and her heirs forever. And it is my desire that my Brother John Shirling should have the whole of my Estate in his possession till the heirs comes of age, and all my Bonds and Notes to be laid out in slaves and put to work for the use of the heir. And if John Shirling and Beckey should die without issue that the whole of my Estate should fall to William Shirling to him & his heirs forever. I likewise constitute John Shirling & Thomas Taylor the sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and every other former testament wills legacies bequests and Executors by me in anywise before named willed and bequeathed, Ratified and Confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this thirtieth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred

& Eighty Five.
