Sledd of Richland county being of perfect mind and memory, thanks be to God, calling to mind the mortality of my body, and knowing that I am appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament, that is to say first of all, I give and recommend my Soul into the hand of God who gave it,----And as touching my Worldly Estate which it has pleased God to bless me with in this Life, I give devise and dispose of in the following manner, First I give and bequeath to my friend W^m Howell Jun.^r All my whole Estate to him and his heirs forever, And I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend William Howell Jun.^r to be my Executor to this my last will and Testament. And I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments Wills Legacies bequests and Executors by me in any ways before named willed and bequeathed, ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this thirtieth day of November Seventeen hundred and ninety. Signed sealed published pronounced and declared by the said Seten W. Sledd as his last will and Testament in the presence of us who in his presence and in the presence of each other have hereunto Subscribed our names. Interlined before Signed the word November.
