Item I give to my Son Henry one hundred acres of Land where I now Live-----

Item I give to my Son Edmond one hundred acres of Land.---

Item I give to my two grandsons John Rogers and Meshack Rogers one hundred acres of Land where Zack Rogers now Lives to be Equally Divided between them-----

Item I give to my Son Amos five pound sterling-----

Item I give to my Daughter Mary one shelling sterling with that part of my Estate as she has already Received.

Item I give to my Daughter Rachel one shelling sterling with that part of my Estate as she has already Received.
