IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN. I Temperance Nipper of Richland District in the State of South Carolina; being at present feeble in body, but of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding praised be God for the same, do make and declare this my last will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say, -----

First- I give to my beloved daughters Eliza Glover, Susan Harp & Harriet Cato each the sum of ten dollars provided they ~~come~~ come, or it can be sent to them, safely within two years after my decease, -----

Second I give all the residue of my effects at my decease to my daughterinlaw Mary Brice and her four children Eugina C, Zechariah E. John Whitfield, and Mary Ann Price, provided my daughterinlaw never marries, if she does then in that case her share goes to her four children share and share alike, and in case either of my grand children die, then in that case his or her share to go equally to the others. My desire is that if my daughterinlaw does not marry and my four grand children live, that my they share & share alike, -----

And I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my stepson John Nipper Executor of this my last will and Testament in writing ~~where~~ whereto I the said Temperance Nipper have set my Hand and Seal this 24th day of October in the year of our Lord 1848
