I Thomas Heath the younger being weak in body and sick, but of sound and disposing mind, and calling to mind that this life is uncertain and wishing to dispose of such worldly Estate as I am entitled to do make and ordain the following to be my last will and Testament. Viz I give, devise and bequeath the whole of my Estate both personal and Real to my beloved and respected Father Thomas Heath the elder, to him and his Heirs forever, and I do hereby nominate and appoint him the Said Thomas Heath the elder my sole Heir and Executor of This my will, and request him out of my Estate to pay my just Debts. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this eighteenth day of August A. D. 1828--,

Signed Sealed, and published by the said Thomas Heath the younger, as his last will and Testament in our presence, who at his request, Thomas x Heath Jr. and in his presence, and the presence of each other have set our names thereto as witnesses this 18 day of August A. D. 1828
