

In the Name of God, Amen. I Thomas Hutchinson being weak in body but of sound mind, do make and ordain this my last Will, in manner and form as follows, revoking all others - Viz, I commit my Body to the earth, my soul into the hands of him who gave it with a hope of its resurrection at the last day - and as it respects such Worldly property as it has pleased the Almighty to bless me with out of which I request that all my Just Debts should be paid as will here-in after shew. Item, I do will and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Mary H. Judge three Negroes namely Lizra, Nancy & Sarah together with their increase, to her and the Heirs of her Body, and if she should depart this life leaving no issue of her Body then it is my request that her Husband Wm. Judge are to keep them during his natural life, and if he should die not leaving a Lawfully begotten Child, then the said three Negroes together with their increase to return unto my Lawful Heirs forever - Also I give and bequeath unto my said Daughter Mary H. Judge Three Hundred and twenty Acres of Land lying in the Alabama Territory - Also, I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Rebecca Dulany- these three Negroes namely, Jude, Henry and Nan together with their increase to her and the Heirs of her Body and if she should depart this life leaving no issue of her Body, then it is my request that Benjamin Dulany the Husband of my Daughter Rebecca, are to have and keep them during his natural life, and if he should die leaving no lawfully begotten Child, then the said Three Negroes together with their increase to return unto my lawful Heirs forever- Also, I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son Thomas Hutchinson Three Negroes namely, Robbin, Chany and Tenor together with their increase, also I give and bequeath unto my Son Thomas one third part of all my Landed Estate in South Carolina to be laid out and Divided unto him by my Executors

his heirs forever - Also, I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son Burrell Brown Hutchinson when he arrives at the age of twenty one years, or Marrys should he marry before he arrives to the age of twenty one years I give and bequeath unto him my Son Burrell Three Negroes of equal value of those given to my son Thomas, Mary and Rebecca, to be chosen out of the remaining part of my Negroes, also I give and bequeath unto my Son Burrell B Hutchinson one third part of all my Landed Estate in South Carolina, to be delivered to him when he comes of Age, or marrys, to be laid out unto him by my Executors Which Land together with the Three Negroes I give to him and ~~his heirs forever~~ Also the balance of my lands in South Carolina say one third part including the Tract I now live on together with the Improvements thereon I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Hutchinson together with all the remaining part of my Negroes to be kept together for her use during her natural life, and at her Death to be equally divided between my beloved Children, Mary H. Judge, Tho's Hutchinson, Rebecca Dulany and Burrell B. Hutchinson, to them and their Heirs forever, as above prescribed in their Several dividends - Also it is my request that all my Stock of Horses, Cattle, Hogs etc., Household and Kitchen furniture together with all other things pertaining to the plantation shall go to the use of my beloved wife Mary Hutchinson during her Natural life, and at her Death to be equally divided between my Beloved Children Mary, Thomas, Rebecca, and Burrell, which may be Effected by a Sale or otherwise at the discretion of my Executors - Also it is my request that for the payment of the Lands purchased by me from the United States, in the Alabama Territory, the same be paid for out of my Estate, together with the residue of my Just Debts - And I do hereby nominate and appoint my beloved Wife Executrix, my Son Tho's Hutchinson together

with my friends John Cook, Claiborne Clifton & James S. Guignard my Executors to this my last Will and Testament; to which I hereunto Set my hand & Seal this thirty first day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Eighteen -

- As a Codicil to the above Will -

I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter -- Rebecca Dulany Three hundred and Twenty Acres of Land lying in the Alabama Territory - Also it is my request that the whole of my Lands lying in South Carolina Shall be Equally Divided between my Two Sons Thomas Hutchinson and Burrell B. Hutchinson, after the death of my beloved Wife. Also it is my request, and I leave it in the power of my Executrix and Executors (Should my Wife and Sons wish to remove from this place) to dispose of and sell my lands in So' Carolina, and with the amount of the Sale thereof to purchase Lands for their use elsewhere, in witness whereof I hereunto Set my hand and Seal, this thirty first day of October in year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Eighteen.
