Reese all the residue and remainder of my Estate both real and personal to them and their heirs forever to be equally divided between them after the death of my said wife Elizabeth Reese or at her Discretion during her Life time, And I do nominate and appoint my son Joseph A. Reese and my wife Elizabeth Reese and Daughter Grace C. ~~Hanson~~ Reese Executors of this my last will and Testament, Thereby revoking every other will by me made heretofore.
