my last will and testaments- Viz. First, the house situated
on Richardson Street and occupied by my self, it is my desire
that it should be sold either by private or public sale as my
executors may consider most advantageous- and that the proceeds
ariseing from the sale thereof maybe applied to the payments
and discharge of an just debts Due by me.--- Secondly. The
following negroes, Joe America, Jim, Suky and Rodia as Well as
all the personal property I am at present possessed of I give
and bequeath to Mary, my wife during her natural life or
widowhood- thereafter to be equally divided amonsgt my
Children in the event of her again marrying- that She receiv'd
a Childs part During her life.--- Thirdly. For the due per-
formanced and execution of this my last will and Testament I
appoint and constitute George Cotchett and John Mae Iver my
true and lawfull executors, requesting them that should my
House and Lott prove insufficient to satisfy my Debts that
no part of my real and personal estate may be sold, but that
they will manage it to the best of their judgement for the
liquidation of my debts and behoof of my wife and family.
