I Martin Waggoner of Richland County in the province of South carolinah Tailor by Traid being in good helth and of a sound Disposing Mind memory & Understanding Do- make & Declare this my last will and testament in manner following that I to say First I will that all my just Debts and Funeral Expenses be Duly piad & satisfied & I give and bequeath Unto my friend James Chappill one house a lot in Union Street in Charleston with all my other lands notes & Bonds Excepting one track of land none by the name of Humleys Land Lying on the waters of Sandy Run & Two hundred Pounds Sterling lying in the Bank in Charleston that Two hundred Pounds I do give to Elizabeth Murph being half sister to John Tilor & this Track of Land Lying on the waters of Sandy Run I do give to William Scogen the track Contains one Hundred & Fifty Acres more or Less - I hereby nominate and Appoint Mr Hicks Chappill & Mr John Tyler Execut ors of this my last will & Testament thereby Reckoning all former & other will & Wills by me at any time heretofore made Declaring this Only to be my last will and Tistament In Witness whereof I have here Unto set my hand and seal The Twenty Seventh Day of August in the year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred and Ninety Four

One negro Girl I leave to Mrs Murph her life time at her Death to Return to her Daughter Elizabeth Murph.
