

WILLIAM MYERS

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN. I William Myers of Richland District and State of South Carolina, planter, being sick and weak in body, but of sound, and disposing mind, and memory, do make and ordain this my last will and testament, in manner and form following---- first I give and bequest to my brother Henry Myers the sum of two hundred dollars and my Silver watch, to him and his heirs forever.----- Secondly I give and bequeath to my nephew David Myers the sum of Three hundred dollars to him and his heirs forever.----- Thirdly I give and bequeath to Mary Barringer the sum of five hundred dollars and my negro girl named Caroline to her and her heirs forever.----- Fourthly I give and bequeath to my nephew William Lee, the son of my Sister Elizabeth who intermarried with a Mr Lee,--- the sum of one thousand dollars and my negro boy named Aaron, and I give and bequeath to the two remaining children of my Sister Elizabeth, one thousand dollars each, to be paid them as they shall respectively come of age, but should the said William Lee, or either of the other children die before they come of age or without leaving lawful heirs, my will is that the portion of the deceased shall go to the Survivor or Survivors and in case the said William Lee and the other two children should die leaving no lawful heirs my will is that the said legacies be equally divided among the children of my brother Henry Myers.----- Fifthly I give and bequeath to my nephew John Myers the son of Henry Myers, the sum of one thousand dollars, to him and his heirs forever.----- Sixthly I will and direct that all my land, my stock of every kind, my household furniture, and plantation utensils, be sold at public sale- the land on a credit of not less than two, nor more than three years, with interest from the day of sale---- the stock, household furniture and plantation utensil, on a credit of one year, with interest from the day of sale,----- but but of the proceeds of which, my will is that so much as

may be necessary (together with the sale of my crop and debts due me) to pay the legacies above given, be used for that purpose, and the ballance of the proceeds I give and bequeath to my three nephew, bandy-vastine Taylor, Conrad Myers, Baron DeKalb Myers, and my two nices Polly Myers, and Sarah Bynum the wife of Thomas Bynum, not liable to the debts or ontracts of a present or any future husband, but should either or both of my nieces Polly Myers and Sarah Bynum die without leaving lawful issue, my will is that her or their, share, return to and be equally divided between bandy vastine Taylor, Conrad Myers, Baron DeKalb Myers and my Niece Polly Myers or Sarah B. Bynum, or the survivor or survivors of them or their heirs----

~~Seventhly I give and bequeath to nephew bandy vastine Taylor~~  
Conrad Myers, Baron Dekalb Myers, and my two nices Polly Myers and Sarah Bynum, not liable to the debts or ontracts of a present or any future hunsband, all my negroes(except the two named Caroline and Aaron previously disposed of) to be equally divided between them, share and share alike, but if either or both of my nieces should die without lawful issue, it is my will that her or their portion should return to and be equally divided between my three nephews bandyvastine Taylor, Conrad Myers, Baron Dekalb Myers, Polly Myers or Sarah Bynum, or the survivor or survivors of them or their heirs.---- Eighthly----

I will and direct that eighty feet square around my family burying ground be reserved at the sale of my land, to the appropriated to the use of my family and relations as a place of burial, with the privilege of ingress and egress.-----

I nominate constitute and appoint my two nephews, bondy vastine Taylor and Conrad Myers, Executors of this my will-----

Lastly I do revoke all former wills by me at any time heretofore made, and do declare this only to be my last will and testament
