IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN. I William Surginer of Richland being weak of Body but of sound and disposing mind and knowing the uncertainly of life do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following.- I give and Bequeth unto Thomas English Son of Robert English one Thousand Dollars to be paid out of my Estate as or at such time or times my Executors may think proper to him and his Heirs forever. - I give one thousand Dollars to my Nephew William Johnson the Son of my sister Rebecca to him and his heirs forever.- I give and Bequeath unto my beloved wife Martha ASalumith all the residue of my property saving one Negro which shall hereafter be more fully expressed and after all my Just debts being paid, which is consisting of Lands, Negros, Stocks of Horses, Cattle, Hogs, Sheep and Goats also every article of Household and Kitchen furniture, as also all Carriages, Plantation tools and utensels to her sole use and benefit during her natural life, with all debts due and emoluments arising out of the same estate and After her decease my desire is that the whole of my remaining estate save the negro above hinted - be equally divided amongst the whole of my surviving heirs, to them and their heirs forever. I Will and give to my Negro Woman Winea her perfect freedom, free and clear of all manner of control of any Person or Persons she She not violating any Civil Law, It is further more my wish and desire that so soon as this my Will is proven that my Executors cause her my said Woman Winea to be legally and lawfully emancipated - I Constitute and appoint my wife Martha Salumith Executrix, Robert English, Robert Weston, and Robert Singleton Executors to this my last Will and Testament hereby disannulling and Revoking all other Wills or Testaments hereto fore made or assigned by me.
