Sixthly I give and Bequeath unto my Sister Sintha Duggins one Dollar I also give and Bequeath unto my Sister Rachel Steel one Dollar, and also after the said Legacies and Debts is paid am Before mentioned I give unto Leloved Wife Harriet all my Estate Both Real and personal and also all of my stock Consisting of Horses Cows and Cattle to have and to hold all the said property During her Natural Life or Long as she can manage the said Estate without Involving it In Debt and should my Executors Find that my said wife Harriet Duggans, Cannot mange the said Estate I Devise that they proceed to sell all of my Estate Both Real and personal and out of the money arising therefrom that my said wife Be allowed a Liberal support During her Natural Life, and Immediatly after the Desease of my wife I desire that my Executors Do place the money that may Be left In Bank stock the Interest to Be given for the support of the poor of Richland District and also such that is not able support themselves through affliction, the principle Remaining
