town district and State aforesaid, Planter, being sick
and weak in body but of Sound and disposing mind, memory
and understanding, thanks be to God for the same, do make
this my last will and testament in manner and form following
Viz -- --- --- --- --- --- --- ---

First, ---- I will and bequeath to each of my daughters,
Jane Amanda and Eliza Rebecca Five Thousand (\$5000) Dollars
deducting from each whatsoever sum or sums they or each of
them may have Recieved either in real or personal estate
previous to my death or demise The ballance payable twelve
months after my decease -- -- -- --

Second -- All the residue of my estate whether real or per-
sonal and wheresoever found or located, I will and decree
Shall be divided into two equal Parts, One Part of which
to be appropriated to the exclusive benefit of my beloved
wife Ann in Lieu of her dower, and the other half for the
exclusive use of my Son John Riley, or their heirs execu-
tors assigns or administrators. -- -- -- --

Third -- I earnestly request my Only Son John Riley. to
watch over and affectionately attend to and anticipate the
wants of his aged and tender Mother so long as she lives.

Fourth -- It is further my wish and intention that my Only
son John Riley shall be constituted the Sole guardian of
his Sister Eliza Rebecca -- -- -- --

Fifth -- For the purpose of carrying this my last will and
testament into execution I nominate and appoint John Riley
McMillan my only son the executor of this my last will and
testament thereby Revoking all wills heretofor made by me.
