3rdly. I give and bequeath unto my beloved Sisters Martha and Margarette Montieth One thousand Dollars to them and their heirs forever. to be paid out of ~~my~~ monies which may come into the hands of my Executors.

4thly. It is my Will and desire that all my Property both real and personal be Sold by my Executors at public Sale and the Amount after paying my debts and Funeral Expences together with the foregoing Legacy of One thousand Dollars to my two Sisters to be equally divided between my beloved wife Mary Montieth And my two Sons Galloway and Nathaniel Montieth Shear and Shear alike to them and their Heirs forever.

5thly. I do hereby nominate Constitute and Appoint my Wife Mary Montieth and my friend Ainsley Hall Executrix and Executors to this my last Will and Testament and Guardians to my two aforesaid Sons.

In Testimony thereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal hereby revoking and disanuling all former Will or Wills Testament or Testaments by me made & declaring this to be my last Will and Testament. dated this 18th Jan'y A.
