WILLIAM PURVIS.

I William Purvis a Native of Ross County of Northumberland England at present in the State State and City of New York I a citizen of the United States of America being in good health & of sound and disposing mind memory & understanding and being about & now bound on a voyage to England I also considering the certainty of death & the uncertainty of the time thereof, & to the end and I may be better prepared to leave this world whenever it shall please God to call me hence do therefore make & declare this my last will & testament,-----

I do hereby nominate & appoint my friend John Hopkins & Thomas Fletcher Executors of this my last will & testament ,

Item 1st" I give & bequeath to my said friends John Hopkins & Thomas Fletcher five hundred dollars each & to their heirs to be paid in six months after my decease. Item I give to my brother Roberts daughter Ann & her heirs one thousand dollars Item I give & bequeath to my beloved friend Harriet Judah & her heirs, one hundred shares of the United States of America Bank Stock,-----

Item I give bequeath & devise all the residue of my Estate to my children William Robert & Joseph to be divided among them share & share alike , each to receive their share when they become of age if any of them should die before coming of age their share to go to the survivors to be divided equally & if two die before coming of age their shares to go to the survivors & if they should all die before coming of age I give & bequeath the said residue of my Estate to my nearest relation to be divided equally among them, said William Robert & Joseph are the sons of my beloved friend Harriet Judah, In witness hereof I have hereunto set my seal at New York this first of July in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred & twenty four,

Signed sealed published & declared by the said William Purvis as to for his last will & testament in the presence of us, who in his presence, and in the presence of each other & at his request hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses.
