I hereby affirm. I have nothing more to give to my grandson
Albert Hoy, inasmuch as I feel that I give a sufficiency to his
mothers Mrs. Hoy Dec^d at the time of and shortly after her
marriageth of the property I have not given off and which I have
now I make the following disposition; Item- I give and
bequeath in Fee to my Son Henry Pattillo Barry in addition to
what I have heretofore given him, two slaves, to wit; man George
a Blacksmith and boy Simpson 2 " Item- I give and bequeath in Fee
to my daughter Mrs. Emily A. Tucker in addition to what I have
heretofore given her, the three slaves following, to wit; man
Steven, woman Fanny & boy Thompson 3 " Item- I give devise and
bequeath to my Son Henry Pattillo Barry the plantation whereon I
now live one the five slaves following, to wit; man Sam, woman
Michael and her Child Laurens, girl Frances and boy Ambrose,
together with all the stock, Provision, Furniture and everything
herein before not given to one or the other of my two other
children; In Trust, ^{for the use benefit and beh} of my son Charles A. Barry to be used and
enjoyed by him (Charles A. Barry) during the term of his natural
life and at his death to rest in Fee in such of his lawful
children as may be living at the time of his death, share and
share alike, And in the event of the death of my said Son Charles
A. Barry without his having lawful Children, then all the
property devised and bequeathed by this, (the Third) Item shall
rest absolutely in my two children Henry Pattillo Barry and Emily
A. Tucker or their heirs or legal representatives 4 " Item- For
reasons satisfactory to myself, I omit making any disposition at
present of one negro girl 5 " Item- I appoint my Son Henry
Pattillo Barry Executor of this my best will and Testament. In

hundred and fifty four
