CHARLES JAMES

The State of South Carolina

I Charles James of the District of Spartanburgh & State afore-
said, do declare this to be my last Will and Testament, (to wit)
that it is my will & wish that after my death, my Son Thomas
James Shall have & receive, out of my Estate five hundred dollars
to be paid to him or his legal representatives, by my Executors
hereinafter named, so soon as they or either of them shall bring
my business to a close and collect the monies that may be due
me, and that the surviving children of my Son Charles James de-
ceased, Shall have & receive all the residue of my Estate (after
the payment of my just debts) to be equally divided among them
Share and Share alike both of my real and personal Estate. and
it is my will that all the real Estate that I may die possessed
of may be sold at public auction by my Executors at twelve
months credit and the money arising from said Sale shall form
a part of my Estate to be divided as above stated. And I do
constitute and appoint Daniel White Esq^r & William S. Golightly
my Executors to execute this my last will and testament. In
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty-
third day of May Eighteen hundred and twenty one
