tween the proper ares & Legatees that is to say Josiah McClain,
Nancy Leonard, John McClain, Elizabeth Ward, Polley Mayfield, James
McClain, & Jenney--Brockman and Last of all I place my the con-
fidence & trust in my two beloved friends James McClain and George
Mayfield as Executors of my Last Will and testament in witness
of the same I have set my hand & seal July 16th 1821
