sire that my beloved wife Elizabeth McClain shall have full
posseſſion of all my property & plantation during of her life to
do & act with it as she seeith proper and at her death for all
to bee sold except the land and plantation which I give and be-
queath unto my son James McClain It is further my will and de-
sire that at the death of my beloved wife Elizabeth McClain that
all of my property shall bee sold Except the land before observed
for my son James McClain and to bee Equally to bee divide be-
tween the proper ares & Legatens that is to say Josiah McClain,
Nancy Leonard, John McClain, Elizabeth Ward, Polley Mayfield, James
McClain, & Jenney--Brockman and Last of all I place up the con-
fidence & trust in my two beloved friends James McClain and George
Mayfield as Executors of my Last Will and testamant in witness
of the same I have set my hand & seal July 16th 1821
