Harrison, of the County of Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E. B. Harrison, a certain lot or parcel of land, situated lying and being in the incorporation of the town of Reidville, in the County of Spartanburg, and State aforesaid, and being a portion of a plot of land purchased by the Trustees of Capt. J. A. Gaston, and known in a plot of the town of Reidville, made by James H. Dickson, as set out containing two acres, more or less, bounded on the East by D. O. Leonard, on the West by lot of B. P. Rain, and on the North & South by street running parallel with Main street; and is ceded under the following restrictions, that no purchaser, his grantee be allowed to sell or drink spirits on the premises or permit gaming in any of its varieties; it being expressly understood that a violation of these particulars is a forfeiture of title.
