I know all men by these presents that I, Jesse H. Barnett, in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and twenty dollars to me paid by F. M. Harmon, of Spartanburg County, in the State aforesaid, I have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said F. M. Harmon, all that tract of land situated in the County of Spartanburg, and State aforesaid, lying on the waters of Jones Creek, and bounded as follows: Beginning on a Sycamore on said creek, and running S. 48 E., 31.75 to a Dogwood; thence S. 44 W., 9 to stone; thence N. 62 W., 33 to stake on said creek; thence up said creek 18 chains to the beginning, as a plat made by J. F. ~~Brown~~ on 29 October, 1874, will more fully show, bounded by lands of J. C. Zimmerman, deceased and others, containing forty-four acres, more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, numbers, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said F. M. Harmon, his heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said F. M. Harmon, his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and all other persons lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

I have agreed to hire said horse for the term of ten months from this date, and pay during said term the sum of Eighty Dollars, as rent therefor, in the following manner, viz: Ten Dollars on the delivery of this Agreement, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and accepted as payment for the rent of the first month only, and then at the rate of seven Dollars per month, payable in advance on the 23rd of each month hereafter, at this said Office, without notice or demand.

But if default shall be made in either of said payments, or if I shall sell, or offer for sale, remove, or attempt to remove the said horse from my aforesaid residence without the written consent of said The Ginger Manufacturing Company, then and in that case I agree to return the same, and that they or their agent may resume actual possession thereof; and I hereby authorize and empower the said The Ginger Manufacturing Company, or their Agent, to enter said premises whenever said horse may be, and take and carry the same away, hereby waiving any action for trespass or damages therefor, and disclaiming any right of resistance thereto.

It is also further agreed that I may at any time within said term purchase the said horse by paying the above valuation therefor; and then, and in that case only, the rent therefor paid shall be deducted therefrom.
