I know all men by these presents that I, W. W. Belcher, of Spartanburg County, and State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of three hundred Dollars to me paid by W. D. Parris, of the County and State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released unto the said W. D. Parris all that tract or parcel of land, containing forty acres, more or less, situated, lying and being in the County of Spartanburg County, South Carolina, on the waters of Thompson Creek off Pacolet River, and bounded by lands of Isaac Gilbert, W. P. Williams, W. K. Thompson and others. Beginning on a White Oak, on Sophie's branch, and running S. 50° W., 4 chains to old points, thence S. 14° W., 33 chains and 75 links to a Spanish Oak, down, thence S. 71° E., 14 chains and 15 links to Sophie's branch; thence down said branch with its meanderings, to the beginning corner together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said W. D. Parris, his heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W. D. Parris, his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other person or persons whomever to claim the same, or any part thereof.
