in consideration of three hundred Dollars to me paid
by W. D. Parris, of the County and State aforesaid, have
granted, bargained, sold and released unto the said
W. D. Parris, all that tract or parcel of land, con-
taining forty acres, more or less, situated, lying and being
in the County of Spartanburg County, South Carolina,
on the waters of Thompson Creek of Pacolet River,
and bounded by lands of Isaac Gilbert, W. P. Williams, W. K.
Thompson and Others. Beginning on a White Oak, on
Sophie's branch, and running S. 50° W., 4 chains to
old point; thence S. 19° W., 33 chains and 75 links to
a Spanish Oak, down; thence S. 71° E., 14 chains
and 15 links to Sophie's branch; thence down said
branch with its meanderings, to the beginning corner.
Together with all and singular the rights, members, her-
editaments and appurtenances to the said premises be-
longing, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To
