Colwell, his heirs and assigns, against us and our heirs, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part, them & without our hands and seals the Eleventh day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Eighty, and in the one hundred and fourth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
