Whereas, Maria West and others on or about the 25th day of October, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-three, did exhibit their Complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, in the County of Spartanburg, and State aforesaid, wherein Maria West and others were Plaintiffs and James W. White was Defendant, and the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court aforesaid, came on to be heard on the 25th day of October, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-three, when the said Court, after a full hearing thereof, and mature deliberation in the premises, did Order, adjudge and decree that the tract or parcel of land hereinafter mentioned and described, should be sold at Public Auction by the Sheriff of Spartanburg County, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in said Decretal Order, as by Reference thereto on file in the said Court will appear. And the said Sheriff, J. H. Blessingame, after having duly advertised the said tract or parcel of land for sale by public outcry, on the third day of December, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-three, did then, openly and publicly, and according to the custom of auction, sell and dispose of the said tract or parcel of land below described, unto Alberry and Geo. Low for Five Hundred Dollars, being at that price, the highest bidder for the same.

Blessingame, Sheriff as aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and also in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars paid me by the said Alberry and Geo. Low, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Alberry and Geo. Low, and their heirs and assigns, all that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid. Said land being bounded by lands of J. W. White, Perry Low, J. Steadman, D. H. Smith and others, containing Twenty-seven and three-quarter acres, more or less, being the same land heretofore set off to Mary White, since deceased, as her
