 To all to whom these presents shall come or be made known in whom the same may in anywise concern.  
 J. H. Blowingame, Sheriff of the County of Spartanburg,  
 in the State aforesaid, send greeting: Whereas Alfred Harris,  
 on or about the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April, in the year one thousand  
 eight hundred and eighty three, did exhibit his com-  
 plaint, in the Court of Common Pleas in the County of  
 Spartanburg, and State aforesaid, wherein Alfred Harris  
 was plaintiff, and L. D. carrier, defendant, for further  
 revenge, see Judgment Roll, No 7939, in Clerk's Office.  
 And the cause, being at issue before the Honorable the Court  
 aforesaid, came on to the Court on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April,  
 one thousand and eight hundred and eighty three, when  
 the said Court, after a full hearing thereof, and mature  
 deliberation in the premises, did order, adjudge and  
 decree that the lot or parcel of land hereinafter mentioned  
 and described, should be sold at public auction by the  
 Sheriff of Spartanburg County, on the terms and conditions  
 mentioned in said decreed order, as by reference  
 thereto, on file in the said Court will appear: And the  
 said Sheriff, after having duly advertised, the said  
 lot or parcel of land for sale by public outcry, on the fifth  
 day of August, in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 eight hundred and eighty three, did then, openly & publicly  
 and according to the custom of auction, sell and dispose of  
 the said lot or parcel of land before described unto  
 for forty dollars, the sum at that price, the highest  
 bidder for the same. Now know all men, that I, the  
 said Sheriff, in consideration of the premises, and  
 also in consideration of the sum of forty dollars,  
 paid me by the said J. P. McCrary, the receipt whereof  
 is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,  
 sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain,  
 sell and release unto the said J. P. McCrary, and his  
 heirs and assigns, all that lot or parcel of land, situated  
 and being in the town of Spartanburg, in the  
 County and State aforesaid, fronting on the street leading  
 from Main Street, just opposite the President Hotel, by  
 Silverdale church, and bounded by Silverdale  
 church property, and lands of Rafe Morris  
 and others, and containing three fourths of an  
 acre, more or less, being the lot or parcel of land  
 bought of Alfred Harris of J. P. Peace. (Above  
 description taken from complaint in case  
 before stated) together with all and singular

the rights, members, headments & appartenances  
 whatsoever to the said S. J. McCrory, belonging  
 or in anywise appertaining, and the same  
 and remainder rents, issues and profits  
 thereof and also all the estate, right, title  
 interest, power, possessions, property, benefit, claim
