To all to whom these presents shall come or be made known or whom the same may in anywise concern,

P. McCrory, defendant, for further reference, see Judgment Roll, No 7739, in Clerk's office. McCrory, and his heirs and assigns, that lot or parcel of land, situated and being in the town of Spartanburg, in the County and State aforesaid, fronting on the street leading from Main Street, just opposite the Piedmont Hotel, by Gilmer Hill Church, and bounded by Gilmer Hill Church property, and lands of Rafe Morgan and others, and containing thence forth of an acre, more or less, being the lot or parcel of land bought of Alfred Harris of J.
