Whereas James Wings, et al Plaintiff, on or about the fifth

and eighty three, did exhibit their Complaint in the Court
of Common Pleas, in the County of Spartanburg, and State
aforesaid, wherein James Wings, and others, were Plaintiffs,
and M. Parker, and others, were defendants. And the same
being at issue before the Honorable Court aforesaid, came
on to be heard on the fifth day of October, one thousand
