To all to whom
these presents shall
come, or be made known, or whom the same may
in anywise concern, I, J. D. Blassingame, Sheriff
of the County of Spartanburg, in the said State, send
greeting:

Whereas, L. A. Mills, on or about the seventh
day of April, in the year One Thousand Eight Hundred
and eighty-three, did exhibit his Complaint in the
Court of Common Pleas, in the County of Spartanburg,
and State aforesaid, wherein L. A. Mills was Plaintiff
and Davis Whitman and others were Defendants,
for further reference, see Judgment Roll
No 7710 in Clerks Office. And the Cause being at
issue before the Honorable, the Court aforesaid,
came on to be heard on the seventh day of April One
Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-three, when
the said Court, after a full hearing thereof, and
mature deliberation in the premises, did order,
adjudge and decree that the lot of land herein-
after mentioned and described, should be sold
at public auction by the Sheriff of Spartanburg
County, on the terms, and for the purposes men-
tioned in said Decretal Order, as by reference
thereto on file in the said Court, will appear.
And the said Sheriff after having duly adver-
tised the said lot of land for sale by public
outcry, on the seventh day of May, in the year
of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and
Eighty-three, did then, openly and publicly, and
according to the custom of auction sell and dis-
pose of the said lot of land before described,
unto Charles Thompson for Three Thousand and
Forty Dollars, he being, at that price, the highest

bidders for the same.

Now, know all men by these presents, that I the said Sheriff, in consideration of the sum of Three thousand and forty Dollars paid me by the said Charles Thompson, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Charles Thompson, and his heirs and assigns, all that lot of land lying and being in the City of Spartanburg, in the State of South Carolina, known as lot No 3, on a plat of survey made by P. D. Camp August 20th 1870, fronting twenty-five feet on the public square of said City, and running back One hundred and seventy-nine feet to river struck, containing a fraction of an acre, being a portion of the former homestead of Jesse Cleveland, deceased, adjoining lots of S. B. Eggle and Thompson & Harris. Together with all and singular the rights, numbers, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said lot of land belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversions and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, dominion, possession, property, benefit, claim and demand whatsoever, both at law and in equity, of the said Davis Whitman, and of all the parties to the said suit, and of all other persons rightfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof, by, from or under them, or either of them.
