To all to whom these presents shall come, or be made known,
or whom the same may in anywise concern, I, J. H. Blessingame,
Sheriff of the County of Spartanburg, in the said State, send
greeting:

Whereas, Amilia Ray, on or about the 25th day of October
in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and
Eighty-eight, did exhibit her Complaint in the Court of
Common Pleas in the County of Spartanburg, and State aforesaid,
said, wherein Amilia Ray was Plaintiff and Mary Petty
and others were Defendants, and the cause, being at issue
before the Honorable Court aforesaid, came on to be heard
on the 25th day of October, One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Eighty-eight, when the said Court, after a full hearing
thereof, and mature deliberation in the premises, did Order,
Order, Adjudge and Decree that the lot or parcel of land
