State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold, released
and by their parents do grant, bargain, sell, release
wrote, the said A. C. Lockman, all that tract or
parcel of land, lying and being in the County
of Spartanburg, and State aforesaid, described as
follows by plat made by J. S. H. H. H. H. in the
19th day of April, 1883, to wit: Beginning at a
stake in road leading to Union from Spartanburg,
Co. H. and running S 79 E to a Pine 12.30, thence S 10
N 1.50 to stake in road; thence with Glendale road
S 7.50 to a Pine 3x D Boyd's corner, thence S. 2 1/2 W
15 to a stake on D Boyd's line; thence S 7 1/2 W 57 to a
stake on Glenn Springs road; thence with said Glenn
Springs road to the beginning, containing Fifty-two
acres, more or less, being a part of my Homestead
