Martin and others, being lot 20 of Camp's Survey of the Cowpens land, containing One Hundred and Twenty-eight acres, more or less. Together with all and singular the right, members, hereditaments and appurtenances ^{to the premises} belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. I have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Lewis Taylor, his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the said Lewis his heirs and assigns forever against me and my heirs, and all other persons lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
