State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold,
and released, and by these presents do grant,
bargain, sell, and release unto the said James
J. Clark, John R. Clark, and Joseph S. Clark,
all that tract or parcel of land lying and being
in the County of Spartanburg, on a branch of
Meadow creek, waters of Laccorn's fork, beginning
on a Red Oak on the West side of the Spartanburg
road, and running thence S. 83 $^{\circ}$ E 31.10 chains to
a stake in the field place of Post Oaks, cut down
thence N 2, W 17.65 chains to a dead Post Oak;
thence S. 76 $^{\circ}$ W 3.17 chains to a stone on the Mill
road; thence along said road S 89 $^{\circ}$ W 9 chains
to turn, thence S. 81 $^{\circ}$ W 6 chains to stone, thence N 6 $^{\circ}$ W
84 $^{\circ}$ W 25 chains to stone on the Clark road, thence
