Meadow Creek, north of Lacombe's fork, beginning  
on a Red Oak, on the West side of the Spartanburg  
road, and running thence S. 83 $^{\circ}$  E 31.10 chains to  
a stake in the field place of Port Oak, cut down  
thence N 2, N 17.65 chains to a dead Port Oak;  
thence S. 76 $^{\circ}$  W 3.17 chains to a stone on the Mill  
road; thence along said road S 89 $^{\circ}$  W 9 chains  
to turn, thence S. 81 $^{\circ}$  W 6 chains to stone, thence N 84 $^{\circ}$
