Northrop, D. D., in the State of South Carolina have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. P. Northrop all that lot of land and all and right title & estate in the same, situate in the town of Spartanburg and State of South Carolina on the East side of North Dean St. known as Lot No 6 of the maps of the Dean Homestead made by McKean Johnston Esqr in June 1878 being Lot No 2 of the First Block of Lots, marked Main

Street, beginning for its South west corner, on a stone, which is the North west corner of Lot No 5 of the Plat (and no 1 of the Block) belonging to Mrs M. L. G.
