 Brown of the said County, have granted,
 bargained, sold and released, and by
 these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
 unto the said Fulton Brown all that lot or
 parcel of land situated in the State and County
 aforesaid lying on both sides of Brown's
 Branch waters of Pacolet River, known as the
 Isaac Brown tract adjoining lands of Fulton
 Brown, m. to L. and S. bracket, containing
 eighty acres the same more or less. Together
 with all and singular the rights, members,
 and appurtenances to the said
 premises belonging or in anywise incident
 or appertaining to them and to hold all
 and singular the said premises unto him
 the said Fulton Brown his heirs and assigns
 forever and I do hereby bind myself my
 heirs executors, administrators to warrant
 and forever defend all and this said prem-
 ises except the dower claimed of Mary E. Brown
 widow of Isaac Brown against me and
 my heirs and against any and every
 person or persons whomsoever except the
 widow of Isaac Brown as aforesaid
 lawfully claiming the same or any part

Lindred and containing twenty one acres
more or less. for more particular description
see plat made by H. C. Leacock Esq. in
partition suit - I do trust nevertheless; and
it is the true intent and meaning of these
presents that the said S. D. McBrady shall
hold the said premises for the term of twenty
