 and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand
 and seventy five Dollars to me paid by John
 P. Cleveland in the State aforesaid,
 have granted, bargained, sold, and released,
 and by these presents do grant, bargain
 sell and release unto the said John. P.
 Cleveland all my right, title and interest
 the same being one half of three eighths
 ($\frac{1}{2}$ of $\frac{3}{8}$) in remainder in the following tract
 of land situated on north Tigger River ad-
 joining lands of Jno P Cleveland
 A. L. Moore & others and containing one
 hundred and fifty acres more or less.
 The same being known as the Pearson
 farm and lying between the plantation
 of Jno P Cleveland and A. L. Moore on north

Pygmy River. Together with all and singular their rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John P. Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors, and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John P. Cleveland his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and all others lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
