 South Pacolet river, beginning on a stone, in
 centre of Mill Gap road, near Black Mountain
 Sheep, running thence N by E 22° 30' to a stone, thence
 S 16° 28' E to a Big Oak Tree, it is a. in front
 3.16 " in a Spanish Oak Shrub, then w 61 $\frac{1}{4}$ " to
 18.20 to a tree in center of Mill Gap road, then along

Witnesseth now by these presents
that A. B. Woodruff, in the State aforesaid, and
in consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars
to the said Howard J. Watters, of the County of
Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid, have granted,
bequeathed and released and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto the said Howard J. Watters in trust unto
or general if lands, lying and situated within
the corporate limits of the town of New Market on
the East side of the Broadwater, and more or less
than one acre of ground, creek, hill, or prairie
beginning at a stone 3x 10 on the said Broadwater
road, running thence N 42° E 61.58' to a stone
