 chains and 26 feet to a stone, thence N 18° 10' 22" E to a stone,
 thence S 71° 10' 22" E to a stone, thence S 18° 10' 22" E to
 beginning corner, one third of an acre, less 25 ft. by 10 feet, bounded
 on the West by lot No. 3, and on the South by lot No. 1, being a
 part of lot No. 2, of A. C. Bishop's tract, deeded by his father
