 County in the State of South Carolina, have granted,
 bargained, sold, and released and by these
 presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
 unto the said John J. Finck, all that tract
 or parcel of, lying and being in the county
 & State aforesaid, in Fair Forest Township-
 containing sixty five acres more or less-
 bounded by lands of Ellen E. Finck, Mary
 Stephens, the widow of William Finck, & the
 Black Oak tract- John J. Finck is to
 go into possession of the Land herein described
 on the first day of Jan. 1884 & not before

anything contrary to the contrary notwithstanding.
Togethred, with all and singular the rights,
members, conditions and appurtenances
to the said premises belonging, or in any
wise incident or appertaining: To Have
and to hold, all and singular the said premises
