 in the State aforesaid, I have granted, bargained, sold,  
 and released unto the said J. S. Turner, all my  
 interest (being a remainder deeded by me & James  
 and myself by 26<sup>th</sup> of Bishop 18<sup>th</sup> June, 1853) in a  
 certain tract or parcel of land, lying and being  
 in the County of Spartanburg, and State aforesaid  
 and described as follows: Beginning on a Poplar, on  
 the South side of Larson's Fork creek, and running  
 thence S. 27° 45' to a Rock pile, in old field, thence  
 S. 67° 612.45. to a P. O. (down); thence S. 28° W. 25.20 to a  
 Black Oak; thence S. 5° W. 22.40 to a Pine and  
 Dogwood, thence N. 89° W. 26.75 to Turkey Oak (down)  
 thence N. 34° E. 25.15 to a Black oak (down) thence  
 N. 22° W. 11.70 to a small Post Oak, thence N. 45° S. 8.30  
 to a Rock in field; thence N. 45° 23.30 to a dead  
 White oak, thence N. 43° W. 13 to a Black oak, thence  
 N. 40° W. 13.17 to a White oak; thence N. 40° S. 14.29  
 to a small branch, thence down the meander  
 of said branch to Larson's Fork creek; thence  
 down the various meanders of said creek  
 to the beginning corner, containing five hundred
