Brice, all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the State and County aforesaid. Beginning on a stake on Martin Pinson's line, it also being the corner of Lizzie Brice's land, running S. 67 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 18.44 to a hickory standing on the bank of a small branch; thence S. 57 W. 23.88 to a spruce pine on Blackstock road; thence with said road 12.25 to a stone, originally a Post Oak; thence S. 87 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 4.75 to a stone; thence N. 81 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 32.75 to a stone, also Lizzie Brice's corner; thence N. 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 26.40 to the beginning corner being bounded on the North by lands of Landrum Finch and M.
