White's land, and running N 41° W 27.00 to a stone, thence S 75° W 23.00 to a stone thence S 10° W 26.50 to a stone on Jacob Wall's land, thence S 87° W 15.00 with side line, to a stone, thence S 82° W 9.34 to a stone on J. D. White's land, thence N 38° 47.50 to a stone, thence S 87° W 5.75 to the beginning corner, containing Sixty six and a half acres more or less, being bounded on the East by lands of W. P. Foster on the North and West by a lot owned by Alexander C. Dotter, Emily S. Burnett and Co. S. Foster, and on the South by J. D. White's land and Jacob Wall's lands. Always with the understanding that the said of A. Foster, now to occupy over and continue the aforesaid premises for and during my natural life, appropriating the rents, rents and profits thereof to my own use and benefit, every thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding. I hereby recrossing to myself a life interest in said premises.
