of the County of Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars to me paid by W. J. Foster, my son, and for the maternal love and affection I have for the said son of the County of Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid, he was granted, bargained, sold, released and by these presents and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. J. Foster, all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the State County aforesaid, beginning on a stone on J. D. White's line, the same, being a corner to Lot No 5, and running N 87 1/2° E 144.68 to a Poplar, crossing Mill creek at 39 chains, thence N 15 1/2° E 73 to a stone thence N 87 1/2° E 172

eastward, thence N 70<sup>th</sup> E 85 links, to Mud creek, thence up  
 said creek, to the mouth of Cedar branch, thence with  
 the meanderings of said Cedar branch to a White oak;  
 thence S 75<sup>th</sup> W 18.10 to a tree, the same being a corner  
 of lots No 1, No 2, No 3, and No 5, thence S 11<sup>th</sup> E 27.00 to the
