Pomeroy of the County of Hatteras in the State of North Carolina, have granted, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. C. Pomeroy, The central portion of the land we bought from J. S. Todd lying on the eastern side of road leading from Mt Zion or Blackstock road to J. M. Wilson embracing the old dwelling house on said Todd land and bounded on the South by lands of E. D. Foster, East by Bushy Drawn, West by Ben Foster's portion of said Todd land North by O. D. Jones portion of Todd land - containing fifty acres more or less - together with all and singular the rights, minerals, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; I have and to hold, give and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said H. C. Pomeroy his heirs and assigns forever, And we do hereby bind ourselves and heirs, executors, and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said H.  hand to me paid by Mrs Ida P. Waters
 of the County and in the State aforesaid, I,
 E. S. Allen have granted, bargained, sold
 and released, and by these presents do
 grant, bargain, sell and release unto the
 said Mrs Ida P. Waters, all that certain tract
 or parcel of land lying and situate
 on what is known as the old Georgia Road
 near to Emma River in Reading Township
 and County aforesaid Beginning at a
