 hundred dollars to me paid by Sarah Gadden,
 of the County of Spotsylvania, in the State aforesaid,
 have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and by
 these presents do grant, bargain, sell & release
 unto the said Sarah Gadden, all my right, title
 interest of in, or to, the lot or parcel of land herein
 below described, my interest therein being one
 undivided half interest, to wit: All that lot or
 parcel of land, with the appertaining house and
 appurtenances thereto belonging, situated
 in the City of Spotsylvania, in Street running
 nearly East and West, in front of the Methodist
 Mission Church, commencing at a corner on
 said Street, being also the corner of Mrs. L. A. Brown's
 lot, and running thence with said Street nearly
 West to the lot of Brooks Storey, thence with said
 line of Brooks Storey's lot to where it intersects
