Adair, John Adair and others. Beginning on a stake, Beahns
corner, runs S. 21 E., 67.50 chains to a stake; thence N. 77 1/4 E.,
crossing head of small branch, 105 chains to Lowwood;
thence N. 15 1/4 E., 96.50 chs to stake; thence S. 79 1/4, 35 chains to
a pine; thence N. 25 1/4, 31.60 chains to maple, near fork of
